“ • We found the biggest hills to sprint up when we were preparing for our return to BUD/S (Navy SEAL training) in San Diego. He'd come over to my house and we'd "hunt for hills".

• We practiced our "Drown Proofing" relentlessly together in the Base Pool on 32nd Street.

• Often I'd walk out of the pool with a boot lace not quite tucked in.

Page would say:

"Yo, man. Fix yourself." Being a minority trying to get into the special operations community was an "interesting gauntlet" to navigate, but those stories are for another time. He was always looking out to make sure we both always at least looked presentable. Great military bearing.

• I told him about Navy EOD school, helped him get through Navy EOD Dive school, and now, 3,200 miles away on the other side of the country and a few years later, we'd meet up on Fridays at his apartment, the Cayó Grand, in Navarre Florida to review what we'd learned while going through Navy EOD school.

• He was there when my first daughter was born. He referred to her as "The littlest Lorde."

• When my second daughter was born, he was there and "fired" my first daughter from being the littlest Lorde and now referred to my second daughter as "The new littlest Lorde".

• We talked trash to each other about which bike was better.. Honda CBR's or Yamaha R1's.

When my dad got sick, he tried to call but I had my hands full and never got to talk with him. His last message to me after a missed call was:

"Pick up you SOB!"

It was a terrible time for my family but that message made me laugh.

He was a good dude, and great friend.

Everyone who knew you, will miss you, brother.
